One K.P. is required for each table. It is recommended that each K.P. serve three meals, staring with the evening meal. K.P's must be at the Dining Hall 15 min. before each meal. It is the responsibility of the K.P. to set his table, wait on the table during the meal and remove dishes and assist in clearing Dining Hall.

Each table should also have a host. It will be his duty to serve all members of his table. Plates and food will be placed at the host's position at the table. It is advisable that the K.P. be served first in order to allow him more time before going to the serving counter for seconds. Serving dishes of food are designed to completely serve your table. It is one of the duties of the host to serve so that no seconds are required to complete the first serving of the table.

A member of the Camp Staff is assigned to each table. He is most anxious to be of help to you and your Scouts. However, please do not ask your Staff Member to serve as Host or K.P. It is likewise important to remember that you as the Leader should not serve as K.P. or Host. Scouting is a program for the training of boys.

The following sketch shows table seating arrangement. The entire group, with the exception of Staff Member and Leader, move one place to the right after each third meal.
