

JUDGMENT CONFESSED BY STODDARD HAMMOND

Today a confession of judgment amounting to \$25, was filed in city court in the action of the People of the State of New York against Stoddard Hammond. It was stated that one of the keepers on Mr. Hammond's preserves had gotten over the boundary line by mistake and cut timber on State land. When the action was begun by the State, Mr. Hammond investigated, and finding his employe had made the error, promptly offered to rectify by confessing judgment in the amount named.
