

○○○ SONG LEADING ○○○

An audience expects six things from a good songleader:

1. The NAME of the song.
2. The PITCH or KEY.
 - Be sure whole group has it - if you're too high or too low - stop, and start over again.
3. The TEMPO - beating time
 - Start and stop together. Leader must be seen by everyone.
4. INFORMATION about the song
 - The words - the tune. Be sure your whole group knows the song. If they don't - then teach them.
5. PEP - ENTHUSIASM
 - Smile ! - Show some life !
6. LEADERSHIP - CONTROL
 - Plan your songs carefully - and use common sense in their selection. Don't ask what song they want - tell 'em!
 - Beware of parodies and songs that might offend.
 - Work for music rather than noise. Keep your songs simple.
