

THE JOB OF THE TROOP SENIOR PATROL LEADER AT CAMP

1. Plans weekly and daily Troop program in advance with Troop Leaders Council.
2. Is directly in charge of Troop at all times; responsible to Scoutmaster.
3. Leads Troop in all Troop, Division and Camp-wide Activities.
4. Presides at daily meetings of Troop Leaders Council.
5. With Troop Leaders Council, plans Troop hikes, campfires, games, ceremonies, and other activities.
6. Maintains Troop spirit, morale, and discipline.
7. Insures that every Scout participates in camp program according to individual needs and desires.
8. Works with Patrol Leaders to see that every Scout advances in rank while at Camp.
9. Is proficient in all Scoutcraft skills and trains Patrol Leaders in these skills.
10. Represents Troop at meetings of senior Patrol Leaders called by Division Director.
11. Conducts daily inspection of each Patrol campsite and maintains high standards of cleanliness, neatness, and safety in Troop at all times.
12. Insures proper uniforming and personal cleanliness of each Scout.
13. Lives up to Scout Oath and Law as a personal example to all members of the Troop.
