Ground Supt. - Polices general camp area, empties rubbish containers, etc.

Capt. of the Head - Scrubs out latrine, cleans lantern, lights it at night. Resupplies toilet paper and disinfectant if needed.

Capt. of the Mast - Serves as Color Bearer for Flag Ceremony at Dawn and Sunset.

Keeper of the Fire - Works closely with Senior Patrol Leader in arranging the program of the evening campfire. He will approach patrols for songs, stunts, etc., to work into the program. He will also make sure Fire is made.

Big Gun - Will see that Troop is ready on time with necessary equipment, for all periods and activities and will assume responsibilities as may be needed in connection with these activities.

Morale Officer - He will attempt to uphold the tradition of our Troop, "A good job well done - with a smile." Responsible for songs at meal time.

Fire Warden - Checks fire buckets, fire tools, and fire hazards, and assists in building of campfire.

Assignments are made to a Patrol with Patrol Leader or Assistant Patrol as the Superintendant or Captain, etc. It is expected that the Patrol will divide the responsibilities so that a cooperative effort is made to provide the service, The Patrol starts its duties at 9:00 A.M. with twenty-four (24) hour service until a change is made at Breakfast the following day.
