

Vanderbilt Bungalow Burns

Wading River, L. I., July 12.—Thieves broke into the bungalow and boahouse of William K. Vanderbilt, Jr., at Deep Pond yesterday, and after robbing the house set fire to the buildings. They were destroyed before volunteer firemen reached the scene. Locks on the boathouse were found broken. There is no means of finding how much was stolen until Mr. Vanderbilt appraises the property left there when he closed the place up five years ago. Sparks from the blaze set fire to adjoining woods and the fire warden summoned a force of helpers and worked all night to save adjoining property.
