

LIST BUDGET ITEMS FOR NASSAU SCOUTS

Campaign to Raise \$35,050 Planned by Council.

Mineola, May 11. — John M. Schiff, chairman of the finance committee of the Nassau County Council of Bay Scouts, and William H. Kniffin, the council treasurer, today issued an itemized budget for the fiscal year, indicating how the money received in the \$35,050 canvass will be spent if raised.
