

4 SCOUT WINNERS GET AIRPLANE RIDE

Soar Over Camp, Drop Message to Chums.

Curtiss Field, Aug. 28.—Four Boy Scouts who won the events at the first annual Nassau County Boy Scout Air Circus Saturday received their prizes today in the form of an airplane ride from the field over Camp Wauwepex, Long Pond, Wading River, the Long Island Scout summer camp.

The boys were taken up in a four-passenger Curtiss-Standard plane, piloted by Van O'Brien, with a 160-horsepower engine. They flew over the camp, dropping a message in a bottle to the scout below: it read:

"Greetings from the scouts at home to the scouts at camp."

As the bottle hit the water there was a wild rush of boys for it.
