

# Scout Camp Has A Rustic Museum

Scouts at Camp Wauwepex, Wading River, Suffolk, have received valuable instruction in nature and conservation methods through the camp's museum, in charge of Charles Werner of Troop 139, Malverne, Nassau.

The museum, a rustic log building, contains a collection including ferns, mosses, rocks and minerals, and preserved specimens of sea life, animals and reptiles. In cages outside are many of the animals and snakes native to the region.
