

## Facilities for Scout Camps Pledged in Memorial Gifts

Although the campaign to raise \$1,250,000 for expansion of Scouting activities will not start until Feb. 26 numerous memorial gift facilities have been pledged and will be installed this year at Scout camps, Arthur J. Hendrickson, chairman of the Nassau County Boy Scout Council fund campaign, revealed.

To date, he said, pledges received for Camp Wauwepex, Wading River, include a rifle range and equipment, Jewish and Protestant chapels, a leader's showerhouse, three directors' headquarters cabins and two first-aid stations.

For the new camp at Livingston Manor in the Catskills, now

an undeveloped, 2,400-acre tract with a 60-acre lake, pledges have been made for a headquarters lodge, main gate, health lodge, Catholic and Protestant chapels, a nature lodge for exhibits, a fly-casting range, rifle range and equipment, four field kitchens, eight lean-tos and two first-aid stations.
