John M. Schiff Scout Reservation in Wading River is a 530-acre year-round camp with a wide range of program opportunities. Day hikes and overnight stays can be arranged for Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, and Explorers with their adult leaders.

Deep Pond, the largest privately owned lake on Long Island, offers fishing for a number of species: bluegills, perch, pickerel and bass.

Two nature trails wind through the property, giving hikers an up-close look at the ecology of the Long Island Pine Barrens. A picnic area with charcoal grills is available for day hikes. For weekend campers, scouts have a choice of using their own tents or staying in heated cabins. Cabins can hold a maximum of 20 scouts and adults.
