

A "Save Camp Wauwepex" fund has been established to raise \$100,000 to forestall the sale of the Nassau County Boy Scout campsite to Suffolk County, according to Robert Crockett, a scoutmaster from East Rockaway. Crockett said the money would allow the Nassau County Boy Scout Council to pay off the interest on a \$1,000,000 debt, and keep the 420-acre park in Wading River for scouting programs.

Last month, the Nassau scout council said it wanted to sell the property to pay off the debt, which members contended is threatening scout services in Nassau. Suffolk County Executive Klein has said the county would buy the property—unofficially valued at \$4,000,000—if it were put up for sale.
