Press releases, hundreds of which flood any newspaper office in a week, are apt to be pretty dull reading. Not so with handouts from the Nassau Boy Scout committee, which manages to be both folksy and suave within the space of some 500 or 600 words. Witness their latest release on the openings of Camp Wauwepex. The Committee tenderly announces "Dr. Frankel will be available at all times, even though some Scout has a 'tommyache'." And can it be Charles Boyer or the County Scout Committee speaking when he read: "When the boys return home, they will have become familiar with the life of Rogers Rangers. . . Could one say any more than this? To lovers of scouting and open air life, it is to be regarded as le dernier cri."

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
