

Health Stressed At Camp Wauwepex

Camp Wauwepex, Wading River — A program which includes corrective exercises, daily checkups on physical condition, prompt treatment of minor ills, and adequate hospital facilities for emergencies is keeping boys who visit Camp Wauwepex, Nassau County Boy Scout Camp, here, in good health, it was announced today by the Nassau County Council, B. S. A.

Center of health activities is the Health Lodge, donated by the Rotary Clubs of Mineola, Garden City, and Hempstead and staffed with two registered physicians and an orderly. Dr. Jules Redish of Lynbrook is chief doctor, and his assistant is Dr. Louis Scovern of Passaic, N. J. Scout Victor Feuerherd of Troop 113, Westbury, is the orderly.

In addition to their other duties, the medical staff instructs the Scouts in first aid, public health, and personal health.
