THE BOY SCOUTS have a camp in Suffolk County called Wau-wepex, which as every Boy Scout undoubtedly knows, represents Waure-paug-es-it, (at the good little watering place or pond). In Mr. Tooker's time, the name was more or less specifically applied to the original settlement on the west side of Cold Spring Harbor. How the Scouts happened to appropriate the name is a boyish mystery we've not gone into yet.
