

Camp Shelters to Be Memorial to Wiener

Woodmere — Three Adirondack shelters will be erected at Camp Wauwepex this summer as a memorial to Nathan Wiener who died July 31, 1947, after many years as assistant scoutmaster of Troop 198. A fund of \$1,050 was raised here and turned over to the County Boy Scout Council's camp committee.

Wiener had been active in scout work. He had served Troop 198 and also helped to organize the

troop at Woodmere Methodist Church. At the time of his death he had returned to his former post.

The shelter will form the nucleus of a new section to be built at the Wading River camp. According to present plans, there will be enough lean-tos to accommodate an entire troop. The buildings, bearing Wiener's name on a plaque will be dedicated in September.
