

## Nassau County Boy Scouts Get Money Pledges for Camp Site

MINEOLA, L. I., June 26.—The Nassau County Council, Boy Scouts of America, has received pledges amounting to \$269,813.66 in their campaign for money to purchase a 250-acre camp site at Wading River, Long Island, it was announced today by Carl Steadman Brown, president of the council.

The drive was for \$250,000. Nine villages are yet to be heard from in the drive.

The camp named Wauwepex, will be used by 2,000 Boy Scouts every summer. The purchase price is said to be 150,000, and it has been estimated that \$70,000 will be needed to maintain the camp for a three-year period.
