

## BOY SCOUT DINNER IS HELD IN GARDEN CITY

**Workers Will Open Drive Soon to  
Obtain \$350,000 for  
Scouts**

GARDEN CITY, L. I., June 3.— Campaign workers who will open a drive on June 11 to obtain \$350,000 for the Boy Scouts of Nassau County, held an organization dinner last night at the Garden City Hotel. About 350 persons, representing approximately fifty towns and villages of the county were present.

The speakers included Mortimer L. Schiff, who is an officer of the National Council of Boy Scouts; George W. Wickersham, former Attorney-General of the United States; Col. Theodore Roosevelt, and Carl Stedman Brown, president of the Nassau County Council of Boy Scouts. Lloyd C. Griscom former Ambassador to Italy and chairman of the drive committee, presided.

One of the principal purposes of the fund will be to purchase Camp Wauwepex, at Wading River, for the Boy Scouts. The reported price of the camp is \$180,000. The remainder of the money will be spent for maintenance of the camp and other scout activities.
