

Flames Sweep Scouts' Camp

Buildings Near Wading River Razed by Forest Fire—13 Other Blazes

Fire struck for the second time today at the Boy Scout Camp, Wauwepex, near Wading River, and swept through the camp grounds, destroying log cabins, meeting hall sites and exercise platforms, and finally racing in a northeasterly direction to threaten dwellings on the edge of the tract.

The fire, which broke out at 10:30 a.m., started at the point where the first fire had been put out Saturday. William Grace, caretaker, the only person at the camp, was ordered to leave his home.
