HERE ARE THE DETAILS of the county-wide drive on tree tent caterpillar egg masses announced by Joseph S. Fleming, educational director of the county, known the length and breadth of the county as "Powder River," today announced details of the county-wide drive on tree tent caterpillar egg masses.

There will be \$80 in cash prizes awarded at the close of the contest April 15. The eight troops in Nassau collecting the largest number of tent caterpillar egg masses will receive a \$10 prize each. The individual scout collecting the largest number will win two weeks at Camp Wauwepex next Summer, expenses paid.

Through the efforts of County Treasurer William H. Kniffin, Bank of Rockville Centre Trust Company is putting up the money.

The count in each troop will be made by the scoutmaster and troops which already have started collection will be permitted to count the masses already gathered in Winter.
