ACTIVITIES AT WAUWEPEX—

At the second weekly council fire held at Camp Wauwepex, Wading River, 112 awards were made as a large group of visitors and parents of the Scouts watched. The principal award of the evening was the presentation of an Eagle rank bandge to Warren Smolen of Troop 139, Malverne, by Judge J. Dwight Rogers of Mineola.

At present Wauwepex "tippy" canoes are in great demand at the camp and more than a dozen have been constructed at the Craft Lodge under direction of Louis W. Felter. The boats, built of wood and covered with canvas, are 10 feet long and have been tested by Red Cross officials, who found that they were able to support a weight of 500 pounds without sinking. More than 225 Scouts of Nassau County are registered at the camp this week.
