

CAMP WAUWEPEX OPENS JULY 12

Camp Wauwepex for Nassau County Scouts will open July 12 for six weeks under the management of the Nassau County Council. The camp is at Deer Pond, Wading River, on a 600-acre tract of woodland about one and one-half miles from the railroad station. The use of the property has been donated by William K. Vanderbilt and Harry Payne Whitney.

Deer Pond is a beautiful lake of fresh water surrounded by deep woods, which makes this an ideal location for a Scout camp. Salt water bathing is also available. The council has the exclusive use of the property.

The boys live in the regular army squad tents with wooden platforms and sleep upon the regular army iron cots. The camp library is open daily, where Scouts may enjoy the best of books. A camp clinic is maintained. If a Scout is found unfit in any way he will be kept under careful supervision and will be given such part in the regular program as will be beneficial to him.
