

Crafts Popular At Scout Camp

Hempstead, July 24—The growing interest in handicrafts as a hobby is reflected in the announcement today at Camp Wauwepex at Wading River that additional instructors were necessary this year to accommodate the larger number of boys taking part in its Handycraft Center. Camp Wauwepex is maintained by the Nassau County Boy Scout Council.

Louis W. Flter of Florida directs the work of the camp Craft Lodge which offers instruction in almost every type of handcraft. Interesting new articles are being made of a new cellulose material which is proving a fine substitute for leather. An innovation is a class in sheet aluminum working.

Under the leadership of Eagle Scout Robert Lotz of Lynbrook there is a special department which turns out the popular "Tippy" canoes. It is expected that 40 of these craft will be finished during the season.
