

FIRE DESTROYS BIG L. I. AREA

Wading River, Sept. 9—A forest fire which broke out near here Tuesday was reported under control last night after having burned over about 1,500 acres of brush and timber land.

The flames swept over about half of the 600-acre tract at Camp Wauwepec, which is owned and operated by the Nassau County Boy Scout Council, Inc. None of the 20 buildings on the camp site were destroyed, however. They were saved chiefly through a fire lane which extends back 1,000 feet from Deep Pond, on which the camp has a frontage.
