

NASSAU SCOUTS PLAN FOR CAMP

Week of Sports Arranged at Wading River

Plans are being formulated by Nassau County Boy Scouts for the programme of the annual winter camp that will be held from Dec. 26 until Dec. 31 at Camp Wauwepex, Wading River.

The programme during the week will include snowshoeing, skiing, ice skating, bobsledding and other forms of winter entertainment. Scouting work such as tracking and hiking will also be featured.
